- Introduce free childcare from 9 months
- Double spending on youth services

The Lib Dems will provide free childcare for every child aged two to four, for 35 hours a week, 48 weeks a year. The offer is extended to children aged between 9 and 24 months where their parents are in work.

The Lib Dems would more than double spending on youth services in Surrey to help tackle rising levels of crime and ensure young people have somewhere safe to go. Under the Tories youth services have been cut by 40% and Woking’s main youth centre, Lakers, has been closed for almost 2 years.
