At the next election, the choice is between hardworking former Lib Dem Councillor Liam Lyons and the Conservatives here. Other parties cannot win in this area.

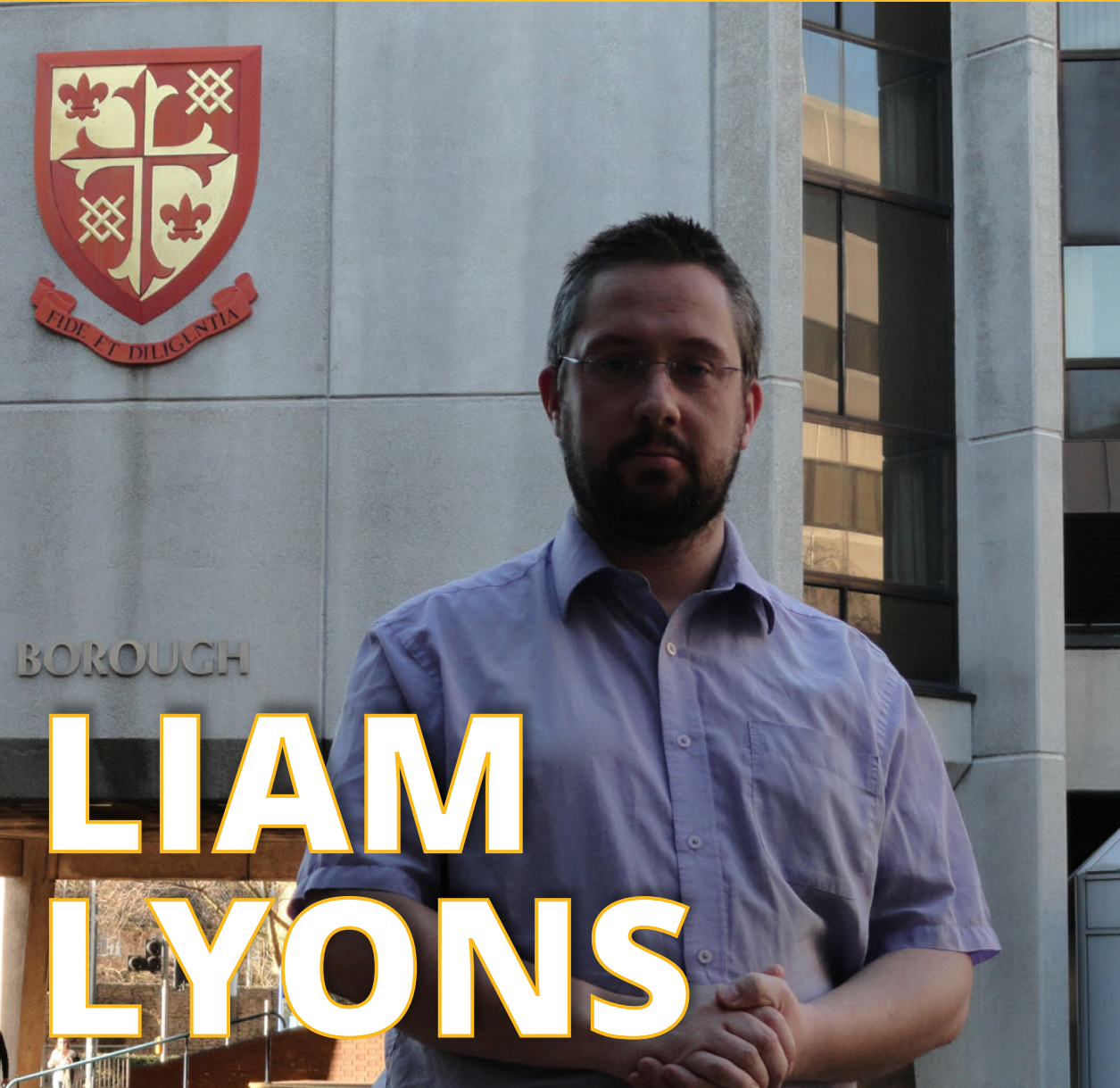

## Helping young people who have left care

Lib Dem Councillor Will Forster has persuaded Woking Borough Council to exempt young people leaving care from paying Council Tax until their 25th birthday to help vulnerable young people with their finances.

Liam Lyons said, "I was delighted that the Council backed Will's call to give young care leavers a 100% Council Tax discount. To expect some of the country's most vulnerable young people to start paying Council Tax just days after leaving care was setting them up to fail."

The highly respected and independent Children's Society has also recommended councils take young care leavers out of Council Tax.



## Liam Lyons - A strong voice for Mount Hermon

As a former Lib Dem Councillor, working alongside Councillor Ian Johnson, Liam has a strong record of action and achievement, regularly helping residents with a wide range of queries and casework, including noise abatement, planning issues, help

with disability benefits, school places and refuse collection. He successfully assisted residents in removing the parking bay outside Lampeter Close, which many residents saw as dangerous, as it blocked their view of approaching traffic. He also

persuaded Freedom Leisure (who run the Pool in the Park) to bring back the 45-degree steps access to the main pool, which many elderly residents and those with mobility restrictions relied upon. Liam has also fought hard to ensure that infrastructure, such as local schools, doctors' surgeries, transport and parking all keep pace with recent housing development in Mount Hermon. These things are not about party politics, but about real issues that affect people in Mount Hermon every day.

Ian Johnson said, "Liam Lyons has always worked hard for local residents, and has achieved many things which have improved the lives of local residents. If you vote for him this May, he will work just as tirelessly as he did before in ensuring local residents' needs come first."

## Stopping over development in York Road

Lib Dem Councillor Ian Johnson recently persuaded Woking Council's Planning Committee to reject an application for an 8 storey development at the corner of York Road and Bradfield Close, as an extension to New Central.

Ian Johnson said "This development would have been too big and overbearing on nearby homes in Consort Court and Waverley Court"

The applicant subsequently proposed a smaller scheme which was approved.
